FRUIT AND COOKIE CRUST PIZZA

- 1 18-ounce roll refrigerated sugar cookie dough
- 1 8-ounce package cream cheese, room temperature
- 1 7-ounce jar marshmallow cream
- Sliced fruit (ie hulled strawberries, peeled kiwis, peeled bananas, peeled cored pineapple)
- Jar of caramel sauce, warmed

Preheat oven to 350°. Butter and flour 12-inch-diameter pizza pan. Cut cookie dough roll cross-wise into 1/3-inch-thick slices; arrange on prepared pan. Using wet fingertips, press dough evenly into pan to form pizza crust. Bake crust until deep golden brown, about 15 minutes. Transfer to rack. Using edge of metal spatula, press in crust edges to form even round. Cool completely. Beat cream cheese in medium bowl until smooth. Beat in marshmallow cream. Spread filling evenly over crust, leaving 1/2-inch plain border. (Crust with filling can be made 45 minutes ahead. Let stand at room temperature.) Top with fruit as desired; drizzle with warm caramel sauce and serve.
